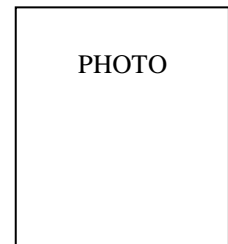

For some Masters, tests and interviews will be organised. **Confirmation of your coming to the Université Lille1 should reach the academic office before 31/08/2017, otherwise the place in the program will be considered as available for another person.**

DOCUMENTATION TO PROVIDE

(UNCOMPLETE FILE WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE REJECTED)

Please provide all the documents respecting the order of the list.

Provide only copies, no original documents. (The file is the property of the administration even in case of no acceptance. Administration will not re-send any document to the applicant except in case of previous agreement between the Administration and the applicant and concerning documents such as original reports)

- Handwritten letter of motivation, in English, one page
- Curriculum vitae (C.V.) with internships and professional experience
- Birth certificate, translated and certified by the French Embassy or Consulate with family name, first name(s) of your parents
- Copy of university degrees (degree of high school included), translated in French or English and certified by the French Embassy or Consulate
- Copies of transcripts of record (starting from 1st Semester at university) with the rank and a brief description of each course
- At least two letters of recommendation from your teachers or professors with their e-mail
- Certificate of your level of the English language
- Copy of any personal work (files, reports, work placements, professional experiences, employment contracts, etc.)
- Copy of your scholarship certificate (if you have one)
- Explanation of your research or professional project (this can be included in your letter of motivation)

IMPORTANT: Since study programs of Master E2SD (second year) at Université Lille1 are taught in English, it is important to master the English language. The decree of December 31, 1991 also stipulates that candidates must possess a level of understanding of the language compatible with the studies they intend to apply for.

ATTENTION

This file has to be returned to the University 30/04/2017 at the latest (with postmark) to the office of Master – Doctorate

Only complete files will receive a decision before 15/07/2017.

The pre-registration certificate is only valid for the Université Lille1 and only for the academic year 2017/2018

In addition to this application file, the Université Lille1 commission can ask the applicant to provide further information or documentation.

Any document sent to Université Lille1 must be identified with your application number.

ANY RESPONSE WILL BE ORALLY GIVEN

RESIDENCE PERMIT

Foreign students, from outside the European Union, staying for more than 3 months must ask the French authorities for a residence permit. However, to help students in their administrative request, forms can be filled in at the cellule des Etudiants internationaux (SH4) from September 2014. Information about residence permits and the documents necessary for its issue can be downloaded on the University of Lille 1 website (www.univ-lille1.fr, click on the button « Etudiants » and then choose « Etudiants Etrangers »).

DISABLED STUDENTS

The University of Lille 1 offers particular settlements to improve the integration of disabled students. However, some difficulties concerning the accessibility for students of reduced mobility still remain. Moreover, studies for students with sensorial impairments need « suitable tools ». If this applies to you, please contact the Academic and Student Life Department as soon as possible before the beginning of the academic year in order to provide you with the best conditions for your studies. ACCOMMODATION: very limited possibilities

In France, student accommodation is not managed by universities (nor do scholarships and grants). In these fields, the CROUS (Centres Régionaux des Œuvres Universitaires et Scolaires) is in charge of this mission.

Student Hall of Residence

You can only ask for accommodation in the Hall of Residence if you have a registration authorisation for the academic year 2017/2018, in a Higher Education Institution approved by Student Social Security and if you are under 30 years old, on the 1st of October 2017 (except for students described in the bullets below).

You need to fill in your accommodation form online on www.crous-lille.fr, click on « International » (fill in online and print). Your file with all requested items must be sent to the CROUS **before 30 September 2017**. As soon as you arrive in France, please contact the CROUS so that they can easily communicate the address.

☞ PLEASE NOTE:

As there are many requests and few places available, the CROUS cannot respond to each application. A priority will be given to:

- Students who have a scholarship or a grant from the French government (BGF), from foreign governments (BGE), international organisations and individual students who have an agreement CNOUS – CROUS – Universities, managed by CAMPUSFRANCE

MEANS OF SUPPORT

Each student has to make sure he/she is familiar with the financial implications of the University Lille 1 program, either through a grant or scholarship, or through sufficient personal means (615 € per month according to the level of studies for academic year 2015/2016).

Please check the legislation concerning bank transfers from your country to France.

☞ PLEASE NOTE:

Given the current situation of employment in the NORD / PAS-DE-CALAIS, students have great difficulty finding a job, even a temporary one.

If you plan to ask for a scholarship from the French Government, you need to fill in a form as soon as possible at the Cultural Service of the French Embassy in your country.

HEALTHCARE INSURANCE

If you are under 28 years and if you enroll in a property or a section of property approved by Student Health Insurance, membership in the student social security is mandatory (400 euros for the academic year of 2015/2016). However, this membership is not required if you have the quality of Entitlement, or if you are employed.

If this does not apply to you, you will have to join a private healthcare and liability insurance. This insurance is mandatory to obtain a resident card.
